

Total Frequency Control REACH Compliance Statement

Total Frequency Control is fully aware of the requirements of the EU regulation (EC1907/2006) on the Registration, Evaluation, and Authorisation of Chemicals (REACH) and is fully compliant with the legal requirements of this directive.

Total Frequency Control is classed as a “Downstream User” and only supplies “Articles” fully compliant with the REACH legislation. These “Articles” do not contain any substances that are “intended to be released” under the definition of REACH and as such we are not required to Pre-register or Register them. TFC will include “REACH Compliant” into the description line on product labels, Packing notes and Invoices of all items that are REACH Compliant.

The pre-registration or registration of any formulations or substances that are used in the manufacturing process of these “Articles” lies with our upstream suppliers. Before approving any suppliers we have checks in place to ensure they comply with the latest revision of the legislation.

Our suppliers have also confirmed that NONE of the products supplied to Total Frequency Control contain any “Substances of Very High Concern” either at or above the specified 0.1% levels as defined in the “Candidate List” (SVHC). REACH regulation has been updated on the 27th June 2018 adding a further 10 substances which makes 191 substances in a total onto the Candidate list.
